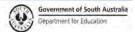

We're going on a spatial noticing hunt.














HEALTHY LUNCHBOX IDEAS

To ensure kids are getting the vitamins, minerals and other goodies they need, it is important that they eat a wide variety of nutritious foods from all the different food groups.

Packing a healthy lunch box gives your child the energy to play, concentrate and learn throughout their school day.







RECIPE IDEAS

Vegetable Slice

Makes: 8 serves
Prep time: 10 minutes
Cooking time: 30-40 minutes

Ingredients: >> 4 eggs, lightly beaten

½ cup self raising flour
1 medium zuschipi grati

> 1 medium zucchini, grated

> 1/2 cup corn kernels

≥ 1/2 cup peas

> 1 medium carrot, grated

2 tomatoes, diced

3/₄ cup reduced fat cheese
 3 Tablespoons vegetable oil

Method:

Preheat oven to 180°C. Beat eggs, oil and flour together until smooth. Add zucchini, corn, carrot, peas, tomato and cheese and combine. Pour into a dish (approx. 15cm x 30cm) lightly sprayed with oil or lined with baking paper. Bake for 30-40 minutes.



Trys

- Using different combinations of vegetables
- Adding half a cup of ricotta or feta cheese to the mixture
- Serving warm with a jacket potato and greens for dinner
- Serving cold with a side salad in the lunchbox
